



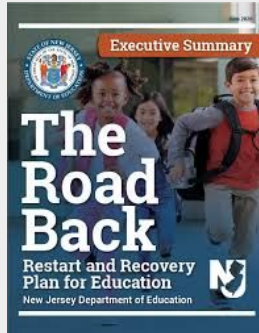
Restart and Recovery Plan

Fall 2020

Introduction

On June 26, 2020, the New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) published “The Road Back – Restart and Recovery Plan for Education” (NJDOE Guidance), a Guidance document to assist New Jersey school districts to develop, in collaboration with community stakeholders, a Restart and Recovery Plan (Plan) to reopen schools in September 2020 that best fits the school district's local needs.

The Board of Education Restart and Recovery Plan (Plan) is being developed to be consistent with the requirements in the NJDOE Guidance with consideration to the school district’s local needs in order to ensure school(s) in the district reopen safely and are prepared to accommodate students' unique needs during this unprecedented time.



The District's number one priority is the health and safety of our students and staff.



Families are permitted to opt students out of in person instruction and have them work remotely.

Paperwork/forms will be sent out later this week.



Phase One

- Students grouped into three cohorts - group I and II will be in person instruction and third cohort will be all virtual.
- Cohort one attend in person instruction on Monday and Tuesday - while the other students attend school virtually.
- Wednesday would be a virtual day for all students. This would allow for a deep cleaning of all buildings.
- Cohort two would attend in person instruction on Thursday and Friday - while the other students attend school virtually.
- Single session in person instruction to start the year with a virtually component in the afternoon.
- Siblings would be grouped in the same group.

Procedures to protect students and staff

- Medical Screening when entering buildings
 - Temperature check - staff in full PPE
 - Screening questions
 - Isolation rooms for suspected cases
- Social Distancing
- Face coverings
- Student and teacher plastic barriers
- Hand sanitizing

Procedures to protect students and staff

- Cleaning and sanitizing
- Hallways and staircases - one way
- Staggered start times and exit times
- Grab and go meals for all students

Contact Tracing

- The Bogota School district, Bogota health department, and the county health department must work together to execute contact tracing protocols.
- The local health department will contact the school nurses and work closely with them to determine possible case contacts. This applies to both student and staff cases.
- Those students and staff who test positive must follow strict isolation protocols.
 - At least 10 days from onset of signs and symptoms
 - Improving symptoms
 - No fever without medication in the past 24 hrs
- Waiting on more guidance from the NJDOE.

Things to consider

- Feeling safe in school
- SEL
- Addressing learning gaps
- Improve virtual instruction
 - Live stream
 - Accountability
 - More rigor
 - All students with a District issued device
 - Professional Development for staff and families
- Childcare
 - Community effort
 - Working with Borough for possible solutions
- Phase II and III will expand off of phase I with longer school days and more students in the building
