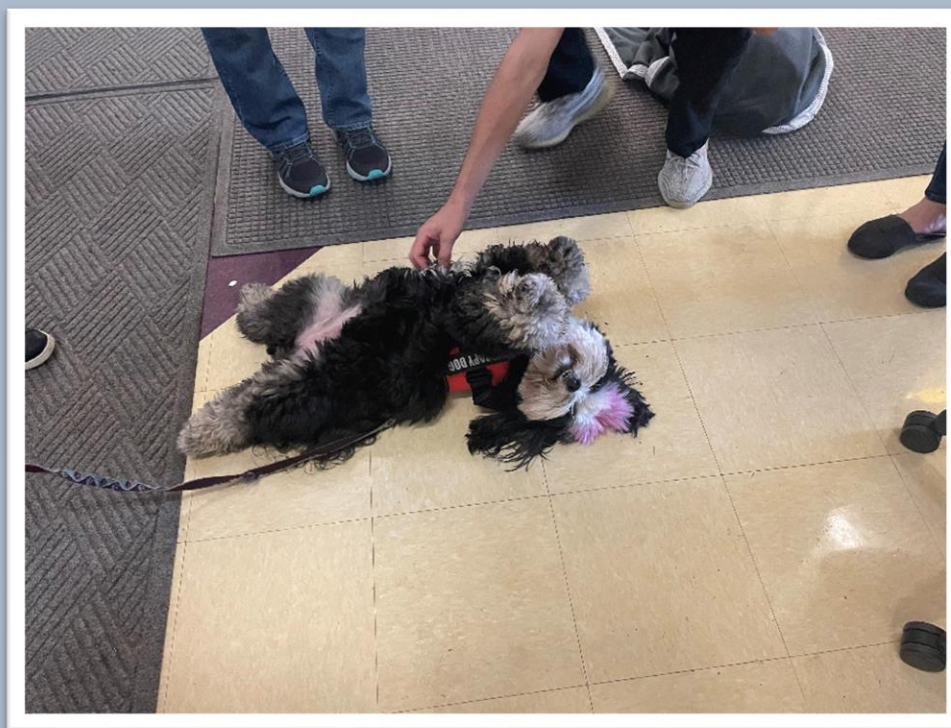


THERAPY Dogs

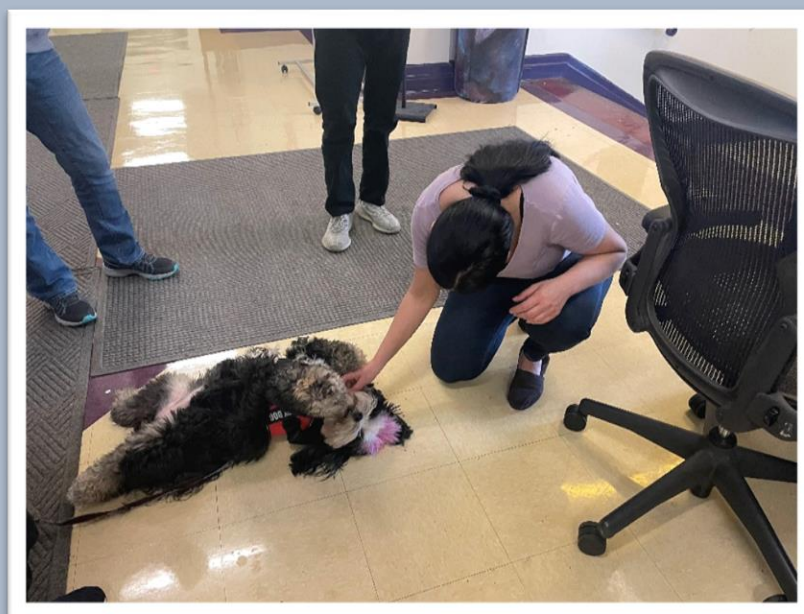


AIR is a School-based Therapy Dog program in which multiple staff trains their personal dogs with the goal of having at least one certified therapy dog in school every day. A trainer travels to your school district and will work with all participants for one hour, once a week. Depending upon the age/level of the dog, the program is approximately 11 months.

They are certifying the dog and handler team together, not just the individual dog with a focus on safety for students, staff, and dogs. They provide specific guidelines for therapy dogs to be happy and successful in schools throughout the workday and have had huge success across the state, helping students adjust during extremely difficult times. Their hope is to provide support to as many students as they can during this unprecedented time.
