District Goals 2022-2023

1. Improve the math proficiency of students in K-7 in Computational Fluency & Concepts and Applications. This will be measured with the normed assessment, Acadience Math, at the beginning, middle, and end of the year. The district will improve math proficiency by improving the percentage of tiered students according to the Acadience Math Assessment criteria.
2. Improve students' reading proficiency in 1-5 in Oral Reading Fluency. This will be measured with the normed assessment, Dibels 8th Ed Oral Reading Fluency, in the beginning, middle, and end of the year. The district will improve reading proficiency by improving the percentage of tiered students according to the Dibels Assessment criteria.
3. Improve student life and school climate through school-based and community-wide programs and experiences that promote communication and engagement.
 - a. Build a supportive learning environment that benefits the entire school community. The district will encourage and celebrate character development, social interactions, and good citizenship.
 - b. Work with families as partners in supporting students' education and focus on gathering data around family engagement, working with families to identify positive homework/parenting strategies, and designing family engagement plans specific to a child's school level.
4. Explore and design a staff-to-student mentoring program to improve behavior and academic outcomes for identified at-risk students.
